Angkor Wat is a temple complex in Cambodia and is the largest religious monument in the world




1. SMALL CIRCUIT TOUR

The Small Circuit Tour of the most popular temples is stunning the Angkor Archaeological Park with major highlights-Angkor Wat, Angkor Thom, and Ta Prohm. These three are the primary temples on the tour destination.

TIME START: 8 AM-5 PM (Sunrise at 5 AM)


DESTINATION: ANGKOR WAT, ANGKOR THOM, TA PROM temple.

2. GRAND CIRCUIT TOUR

The further temple group from Small Circuit Tour such as Preah Khan, Neak Pean to the Eastern Mebon and monuments Ta Som & Pre Rup. This tour also offers the opportunity to explore Banteay Srei (Lady temple or Pink Sand-stone Temple). This temple is located about 37km away from Siem Reap city center Also known for the beauty of the deepest carving details.

TIME START: 8 AM-5 PM

DESTINATION: Banteay Srei, Landmine museum, Banteay Samre, Preah khan, Neak Pean East Mebon, Pre Rub.

3. KULEN NATIONAL PARK

Phnom Kulen National Park is located in Svay Leu District about 48 km from Siem Reap and about 25 km from Banteay Srey. There are several natural features, historical places, and other sights making Kulen National Park an interesting place to visit such as a waterfall, and Linga 1,000 figures carved into the rocks of the riverbed and banks. Preah Ang Thom is an 8 m tall statue of the reclining Buddha reaching nirvana. The statue is carved into a huge sandstone boulder.

START: 8 AM-5 PM

DESTINATION: Preah Ang Thom, 1,000 Linga,

Waterfall.





4. KBAL SPEAN & BANTEAY SREI

The Kbal Spean also known as the "Valley of a thousand Lingas", is located on the mountain, along the Kbal Spean River, which is a tributary of the Siem Reap River. The site has many figures of Yoni and Linga. The site is accessible by trekking uphill through 1.5 km.

TIME START: 8 AM -5 PM

DESTINATION: Waterfall, Thousand Lingas, Banteay

5. PHNOM KULEN & BANTEAY SREI

Phnom Kulen National Park is a sacred plateau where located 50 km north of Siem Reap city. Learn why the site serves as a place of pilgrimage to both Hindus and Buddhists by visiting the Giant Reclining Buddha, the River of 1,000 Linga, and the Kulen Waterfalls.


TIME START: 8 AM -5 PM

6. BENG MEALEA & BANTEAY SREI
Beng Mealea was built as a Hindu temple, but
some carvings depict Buddhist motifs. Its
primary material is sandstone and it is largely
unrestored, with trees and thick brush thriving
amidst its towers and courtyards and many of
its stones lying in great heaps. About 49 km
from temple of Banteay Srei.

TIME START: 8 AM –5 PM
DESTINATION: Banteay Srei Temple, Beng
Mealea

7. BENG MEALEA & KOH KER
Koh Ker is a remote archaeological site in
northern Cambodia about 120 km away from
Siem Reap and the ancient site of Angkor and
about 57km from temple of Beng Mealea.
